The publication contains statistical data on the education of foreign students in Ukraine as of January 1st, 2023, and outlines results for the survey of 3445 foreign students studying in Ukrainian universities. The publication is aimed at a wide audience.

The survey of foreign students was conducted by the State Enterprise "Ukrainian State Center for International Education" in the period from May 4th to September 23rd, 2023, in interview and online questionnaire formats.

The statistical data on the number of individuals who studied/are studying at the level of vocational pre-university education and levels of higher education (primary (short cycle), first (bachelor), second (master), third (educational and scientific/ educational and creative) was provided by the SE "Inforesource" from the Unified State Electronic Database on Education as of January 1st, 2023. The data on the number of individuals who studied/are studying at a post-graduate level, under academic mobility programs, as well as students of preparatory faculties, departments (subdivisions) on studying the state language and/or the language of instruction was provided by the SE "Ukrainian State Center for International Education" from the AS "Electronic Journal" as of January 1st, 2023.

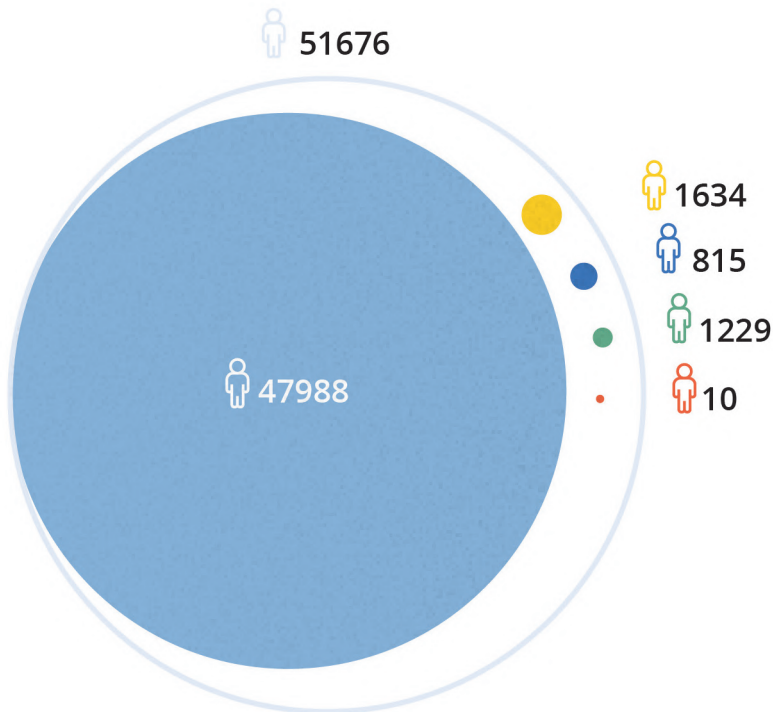

## 1.1. Number of foreign students in Ukrainian universities as of 01.01.2023



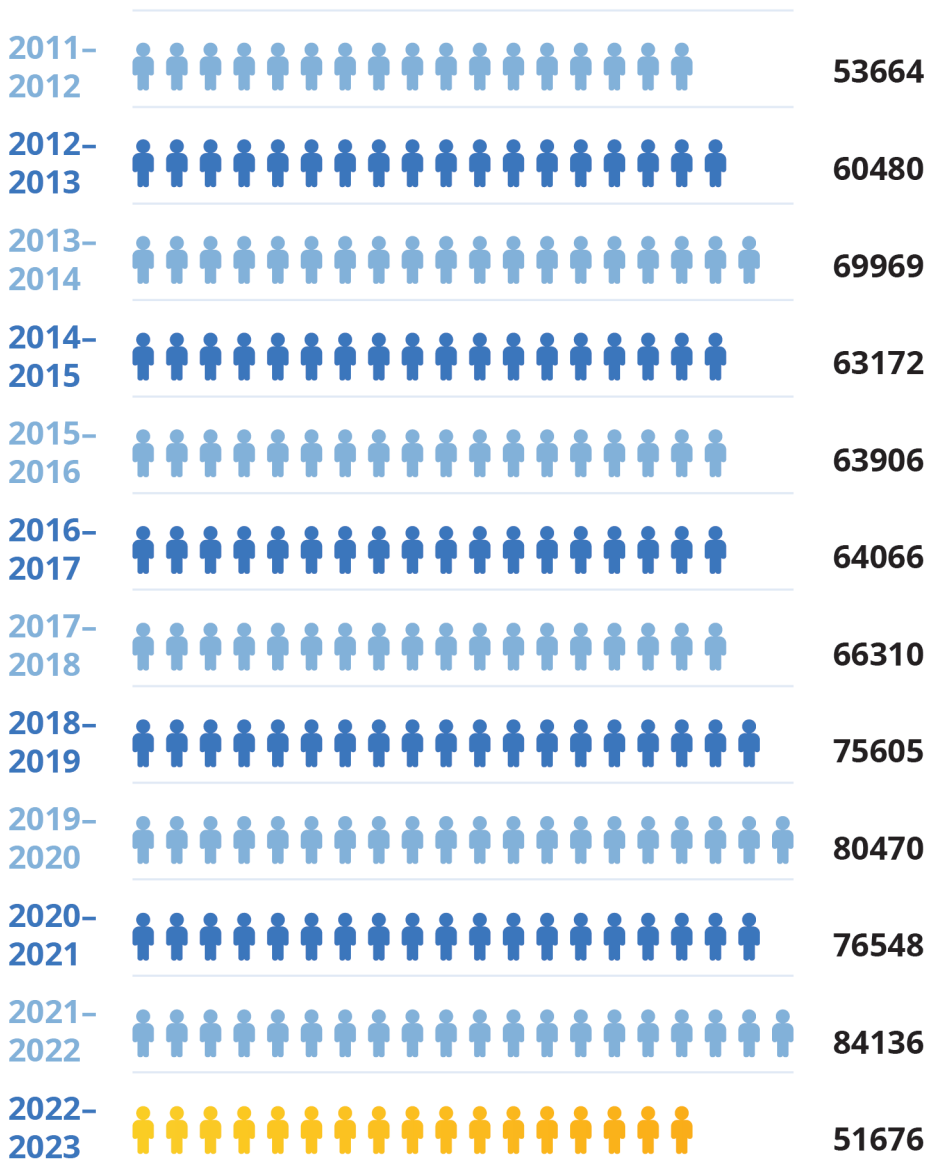

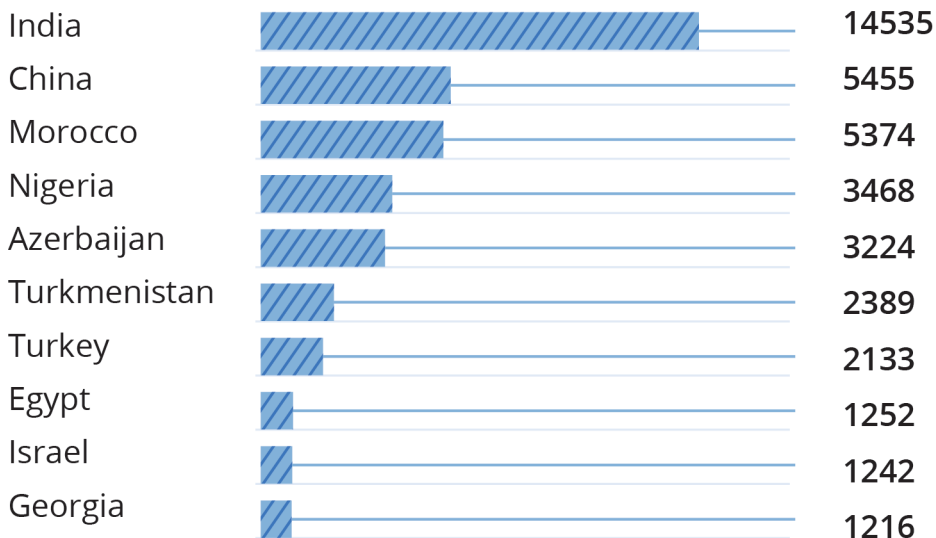
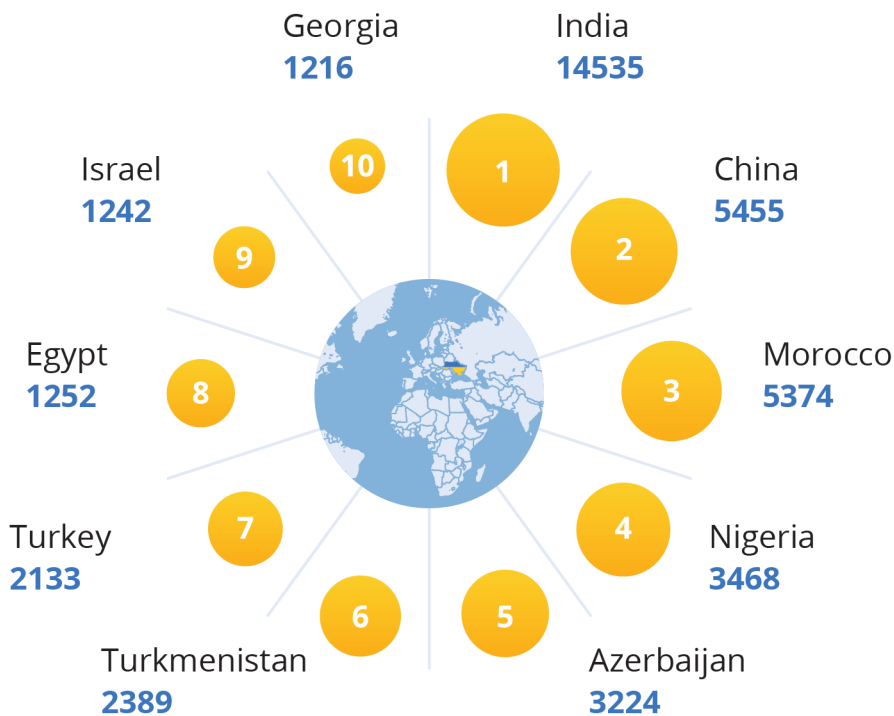

## 1.2. Number of foreign students in Ukraine (2011 - 2023)

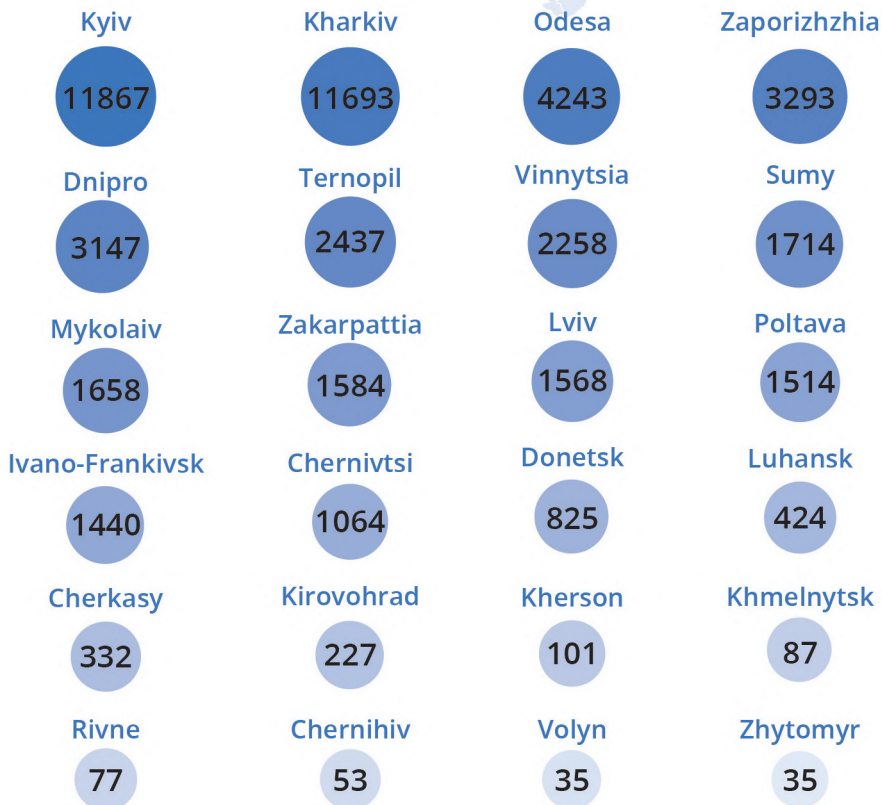
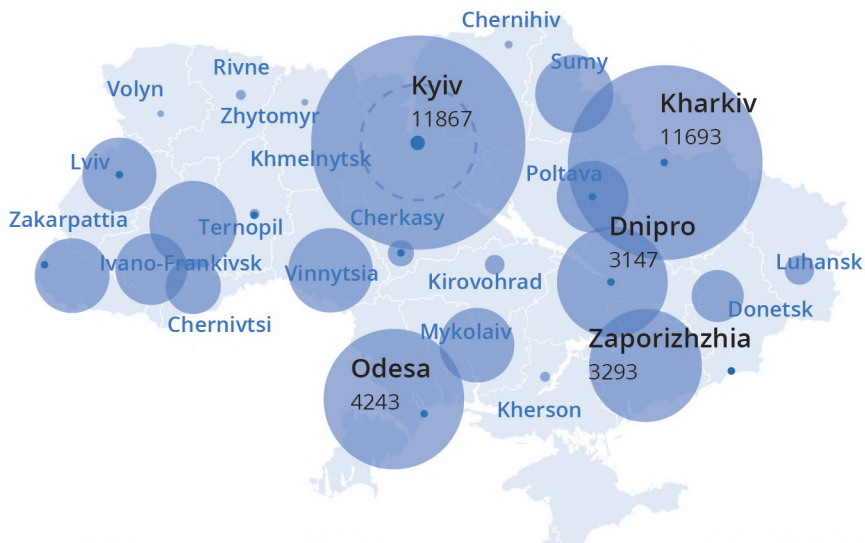


### 1.3. Top 10 countries by origin of foreign students

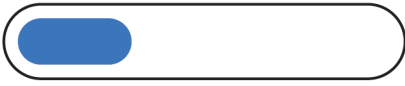

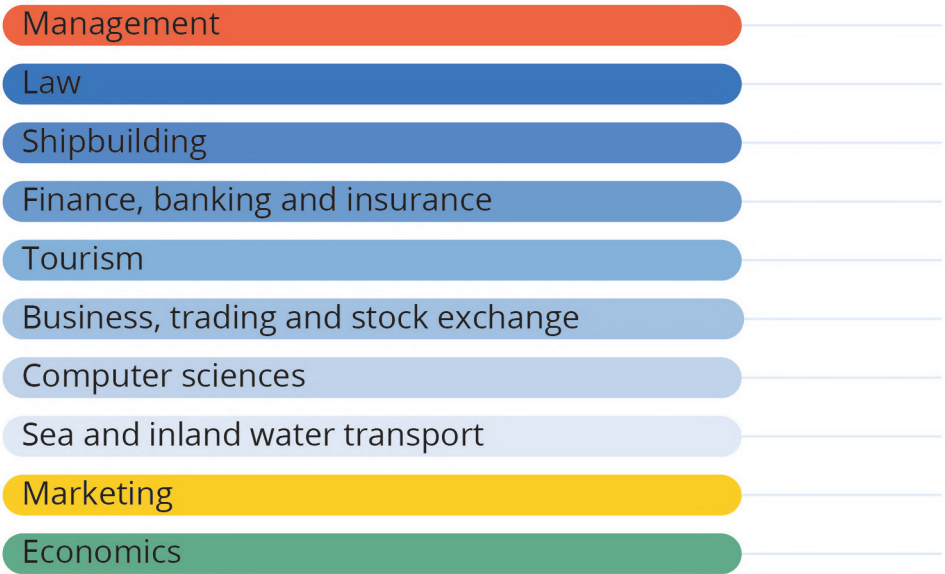

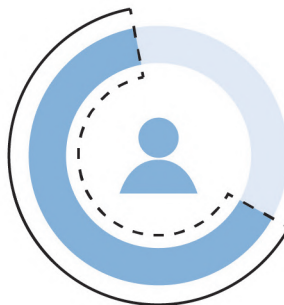

### 3.4. Number of registered invitations for study for foreign students

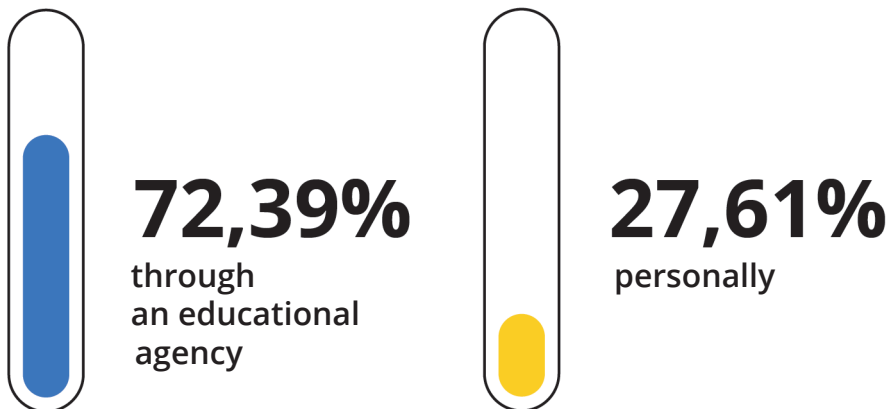

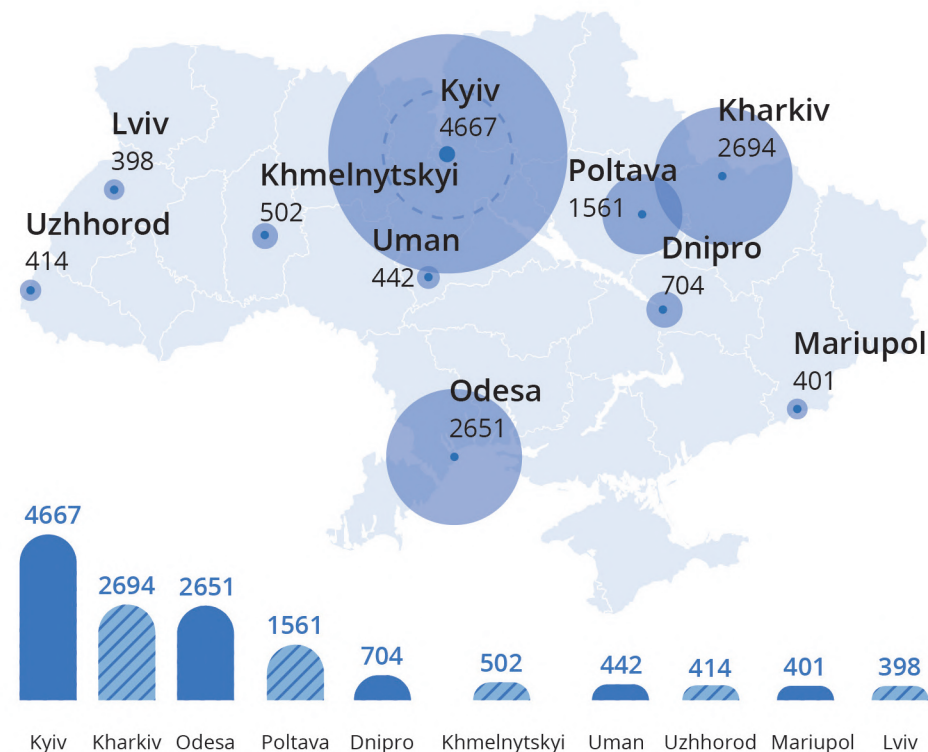

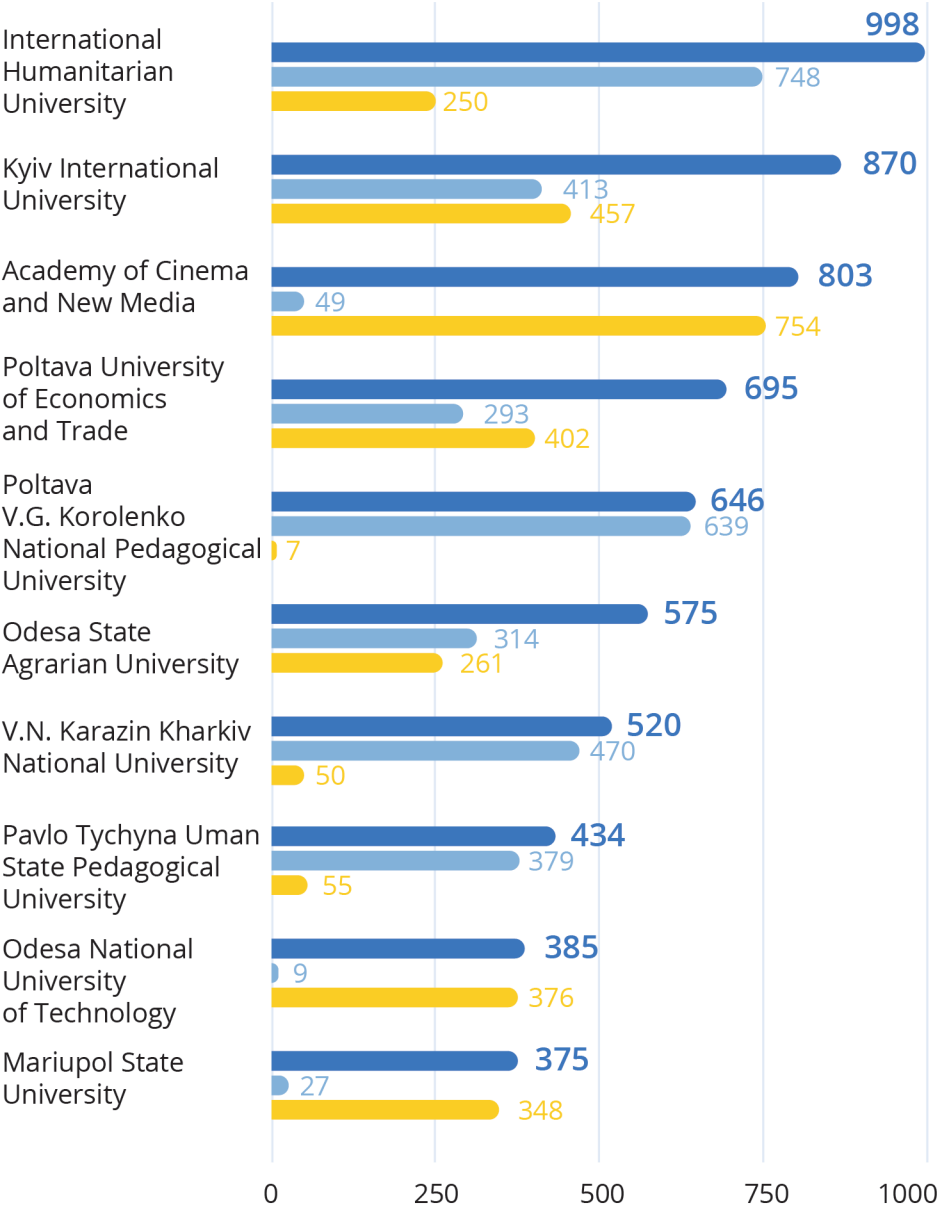


### 3.7. Top 10 cities by number of registered invitations for foreign students

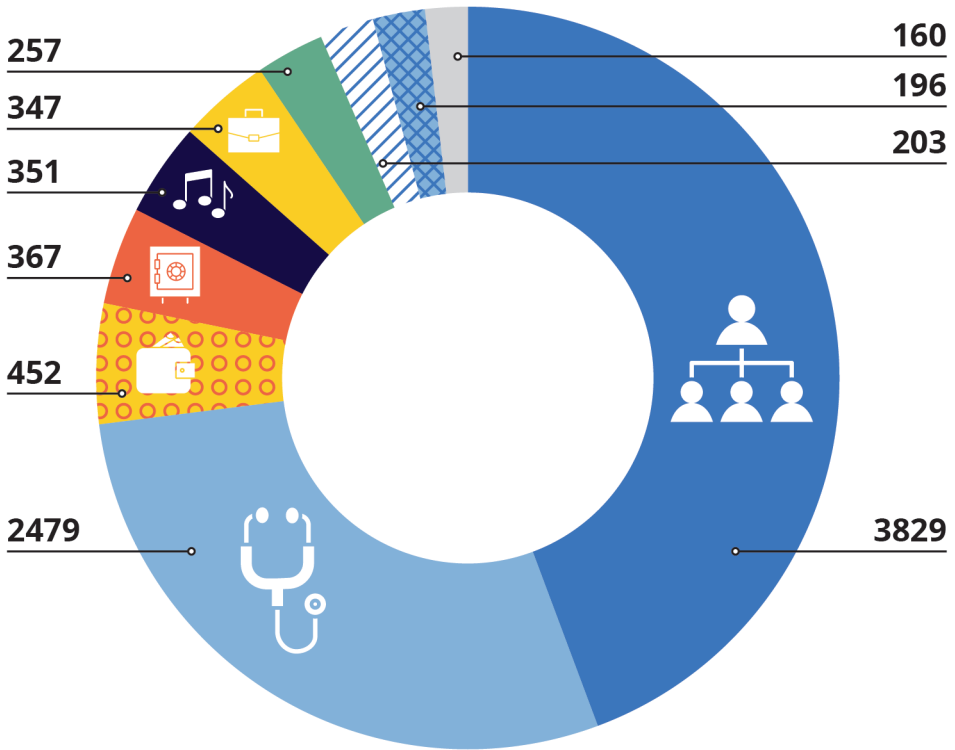


### 3.8. Top 10 universities by number of registered invitations for foreign students

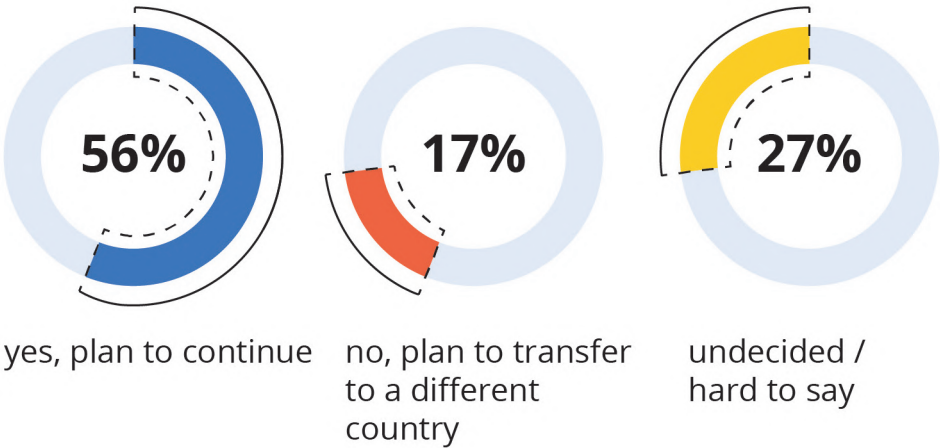

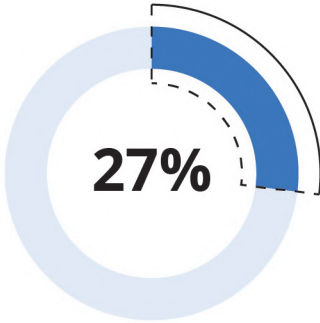
## 4.2. Do foreign students plan to continue studying in Ukraine if martial law is extended?



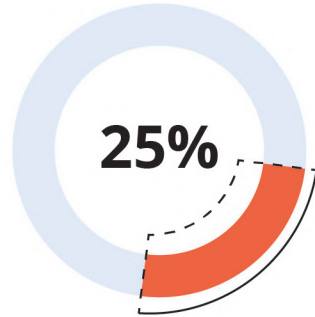
## 4.3. Do foreign students plan to work in the specialty that they are studying in Ukraine?



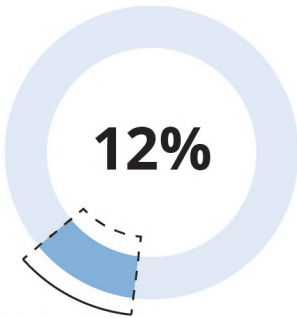
#### 4.4. What are the biggest issues of Ukrainian education in foreign students' opinion?



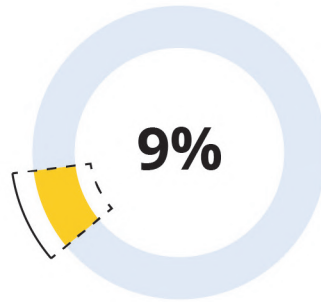

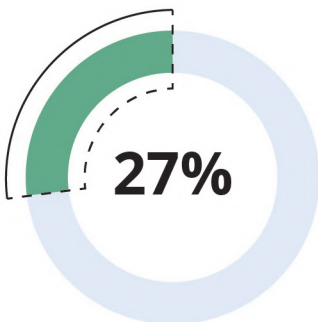

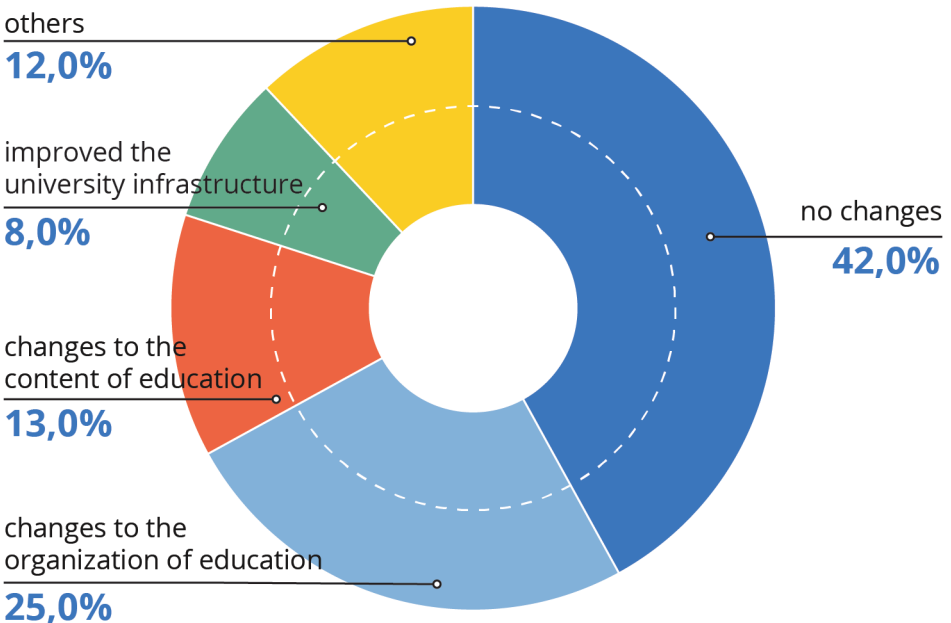
